Collection names:

BLT-menu consists four collections: Confetti; Bright Light; Litte Twist & New Things.

Material:

The finishing plates are made from solid surface; the switches and rotary knobs are made from solid surface and brass.

Treatments:

During production, the finishing plates undergo a honing process to achieve a matte appearance. The solid surface finishing plates require no maintenance; you can even put them in the dishwasher. To keep the aged brass buttons looking their best, apply beeswax. The polished brass buttons are coated with a lacquer finish and require no maintenance.

Color:

The BLT menu is available in a standard selection of 14 solid colors and 7 patterned designs. Custom colors can also be created upon request.

Options:

In addition to the standard colors, Bright Little Things can work with any brand's 12 mm thick solid surface plates. Custom colors are also possible.

Dimensions:

The single finishing plates measure 90 x 90 x 12 mm. The double finishing plate measures 161 x 90 x 12 mm, and the triple measures 232 x 90 x 12 mm. Each additional function increases the length by 71 mm.

The BLT menu is a range of finishing plates compatible with renowned in-wall dimmer mechanisms from brands such as Gira, Jung, and Merten. For switching and pulse functions, the corresponding Merten in-wall component is used. For earthed wall sockets, the Niko in-wall component is incorporated.
